Introduction

This index is intended to provide an easy way to locate the particular Little League® rule(s) or regulation(s) covering a specific situation.

Certain rules are specific to either baseball or softball. In addition, in some situations, the same rule is numbered slightly differently in the baseball rulebook versus the softball rulebook. Finally, there are rules that are specific to the All Star Tournament, as well as relevant comments in *Make The Right Call, The Casebook of Little League*. To help sort through all of this, the following prefixes are used where appropriate:

2014 Rule Change Summary

Reg II	Changed residency requirements to allow players to play for a league whose boundaries include the school they attend
Reg IV	Clarification that players must have amateur status in all divisions
Reg VI(b) - BB	Pitchers who cross a "rest" threshold during an at-bat may use the lower threshold the at-bat ends the game
Reg VI(b) - SB	M/M - pitchers are limited to 12 innings a day, and require one calendar day of rest if pitching more than six innings. (Approved at 2014 LL Congress)
Reg VI	The 2014 book omitted the regular season exception that called for pitching and batting records to be wiped out if the first inning of a game was not completed. This was an inadvertent omission, and the exception should still be considered to apply
Reg VII(d)	M/M may play 2 doubleheaders a week. J/S/B may play three games a day. (Approved at 2014 LL Congress)
Reg VIII(d)	5-year-olds may participate in Coach Pitch/Machine Pitch (Approved at 2014 LL Congress)
